## What is Not Allowed to be worn in School?

- Football or sports tops
- × Jogging bottoms
- ✗ Jewellery, especially rings, long necklaces and dangling earrings or loose fitting clothing. These are very dangerous in practical classes
- Clothes that carry advertising or logos

If there may be a reason why you do not wear your uniform on a particular day you should bring a note of explanation to your Year Head at the beginning of that day.



Please Note: Leggings, joggers and hoodies are only allowed to be worn for PE. These are not part of your day to day uniform.
